Enfield's ERWL Hat trick – Hillingdon spring a surprise!

In the individual competition Callum Wilkinson thought he was home and dry with a nine point lead following the eleventh race, but to avoid the outside chance that a large field in the last race of the year would make it possible for his rival Fransisco Reis to pip him, he duly turned out at Hillingdon and put the matter beyond doubt. At seventeen years of age he is the youngest ever League winner.

Helen Middleton regained the Pam Phillips trophy as the Women's victor for the fourth time equalling the number of wins recorded by Ann Lewis between 2001 and 2004. Finishing second for the sixth time was Fiona Bishop, whilst Angela Martin retained the third spot she occupied last year. It should be noted that Fiona also won the League in 2008 and 2009.

Enfield & Haringey AC were untroubled in retaining the team championship for the fifth consecutive year. However, the big surprise was Hillingdon AC's elevation to the runner-up position after occupying third place for the previous two years. The HAC walkers took full advantage of a sparse Ilford AC presence in the last race to close down and surpass the 134 points advantage the Essex club had going into the race. More on page 2



League Report continued

Forty-six clubs representing 138 walkers of which 41were women took part in the 2014 *League*. In total they collectively amassed 488 performances; an average fractionally above 40 per fixture and 34 competed at least six races to earn *Leaguer* status, among them u13 George Wilkinson. More than half of those who qualified as *Leaguers* put in nine or more appearances, with Fransisco Reis, Helen Middleton and Sean Pender doing them all!



The leading Centurion was Stuart Bennett and in all 32 members of the Brother/Sisterhood took part in the series Twenty-six competed, among them seven who also officiated at some races and six who officiated only.

Thanks to all the officials, many of who put in sufficient appearances to merit *Leaguer* status themselves and of course Jon May (*pictured*) for the mountain of work he does for the *League* in compiling the tables and handicaps.

Result Round-up

The **Midland RWA Winter League** wound up at Coventry on 23rd November with races at varying distances for various age groups. In the 10km won by Leicester's Tanya Gabellone in 49.09 Sean Pender finished seventh in 61.40 just nine seconds behind *Leaguer* Dan Maskell, whilst David Hoben recorded 69.30. In the 5km, Peter Cassidy clocked 36.00.

There was a good turnout for the first of the **Cambridge H Winter league 5kms** at Bexley on 6th December, with 29 walkers of which 15 were under 20years of age. Cameron Corbishley won comfortably in 22.35 from Heather Butcher in 25.02 and Jonathan Hobbs 25.07. Good showings in 5th and 6th places by the Snook Brothers; Chris (u17) 25.41 and Tim (u20) 26.52. In addition to Sean Pender on judging duty *League* interest in the event were the performances by Malc and Angela Martin 27.14 and 34.25 respectively, Dave Hoben 35.13, Mick Barnbrook 36.27 and Dave Ainsworth 40.40.

Luc Legon won the 'Alf Palmer' 5km at Broadheath track, Horsham on 13th December. Luc's time was 24.45 and he was followed home by Ian Richards 24.52 and Chris Hobbs the new SRWA President 25.24. *Leaguers* Trevor Jones 26.42, Malc Martin 27.45, Anne Jones 32.04, Shaun Lightman 33.57, Dave Hoben 34.00 and Angela Martin 34.34 were among the 18 starters. Under 15 year-old Lucy Lewis Ward 16.49 won the 3km race.

Guy Thomas (u20) in his first race for some time won the **Surrey Christmas 5km** at Tonbridge on 20th December. His time was a swift 22.10 and he finished well clear of the main field. Fransisco Reis was second in 24.10 and David Crane third in 25.23. Sean Pender was the lone club walker recording 31.34 in 7th place, whilst *Leaguers* Malc Martin 27.04, Dan Maskell 31.02, Shaun Lightman 31.37, Dave Hoben 34.08 and Angela Martin 34.20 were among the 18 strong field.
