89th Enfield Open Seven - Top Juniors Take Top Places





Emma Achurch and Callum Wilkinson the country's leading under 20 race walkers were outstanding winners at the 89<sup>th</sup> edition of the Enfield Open Seven staged at LVAC on 14<sup>th</sup> November. Both started university courses this autumn and these performances suggest that they have transitioned to student life pretty well. Luc Legon (87) walked stride for stride with Emma (85) to get under the hour for the first time. *No 79 is Chris Hobbs*.

In 2013 at 16 Callum was delighted to be the youngest ever winner of the event, but disappointed with his time of 57.46 and vowed to do better. He certainly kept his promise and on

this occasion he stopped the clock at 47.28, the fastest ever winning time in the long history of the event. Centurions Dominic and Daniel King

pushed Wilkinson early on, but with their training aimed at 50km didn't have the edge and it is to their credit that although not really racing fit, they supported the event. Francisco Reis was the outstanding veteran and young Chris Snook impressed in the supporting race.

The Spot prize winners were: Graham Chapman, Ken Bobbett, Hannah Childs and Brian Kirkdale and these along with the other awards were presented by event sponsor Bernie Hercock (*pictured right*) Full result on page 2

Shaun Doing Well Within a week of finishing 18th in the Open 7, a race he won in 1969/72 &76, Olympian (1968) Shaun Lightman spent 24 hours in hospital having a heart pacemaker fitted. He told me that his progress has been good and he returns to the hospital for a follow-up appointment towards the end of December after which he hopes to be able to drive again.

## Results Round up

Twelve walkers started the **Surrey Walking Club Open 7 miles** at Addiscombe on 1<sup>st</sup> November, a welcome trend following the previous fixture where only six did so. David Crane set a pb of 57.04 to relieve Mark Easton 60.11, of the *Potton Cup* which he had held for over three decades. In the *Gazette* 4 miles a month earlier Mark had been able to hold off the younger athlete and because of the longer distance, a much closer contest had been anticipated. Mark tried valiantly to shake off his rival in the early laps of what is a testing course but failed to do so and although walking over a minute quicker than in 2014 couldn't hold the much improved Surrey walker. Dan Maskell 72.43 repeated his third place of 2014. Sean Lightman 74.04, Paul King, 75.38, Fiona Bishop 75.41 (1<sup>st</sup> Woman), Anne Jones 76.08, Peter Hannell 77.32, Geraldine Legon 79.21, David Delaney 80.15 and Dave Hoben 82.22 were the other finishers.

**Lancashire Walking Club** had an excellent turn-out of 19 walkers for its **AGM 5km** at Simister on 7<sup>th</sup> November. The promoting club's former international Tony Taylor won the event in 26.45 and ERWL interest was in Dan Maskell who finished 5<sup>th</sup> in 30.04.

Mark Williams was the 10km winner of a well supported final **Midland Winter League** at Warwick University on 15<sup>th</sup> November which embraced various distances and age groups. Sean Pender recorded 67.28 and Dan Maskell in the 5km 30.57.
