Tokyo Olympians spanning six decades made history at the Moulton Five as Callum Wilkinson, fresh from his splendid 20km 10<sup>th</sup> at this year's Games, came under the starting orders of Ray Middleton a GB stalwart of the 1960's, who competed at the 1964 Tokyo Olympics at 50km.

Olympian Wilkinson kept his brother George company for most of the way before easing ahead for the win, with the 2017 runner-up Dave Annetts in third place, some five minutes quicker than he was back then.

Although walking over two minutes faster than her winning time of 2019, Emma Dyos was unable to prevent the recent master's record breaker Melanie Peddle from relieving her of the winner's trophy.

Following a two year break and a residual covid concern, numbers were understandably down on previous years, but the 'buzz' warmth and friendliness associated with this event was as overwhelming as ever. Ray Middleton at 85, remains the likeable character he always was and was joined by peers Bill Sutherland, George Nibre, Tony Taylor and Ron Wallwork.
