ERWL 2023 Fixture 1 – 14th January at King George Playing Fields, Enfield. Cat A (Permit No: RWA23006-1)

The opening race of the season was staged on 14th January in appalling conditions and attracted 24 competitors representing

eleven clubs. Standing water on parts of the course and debris scattered about around one of the turns must have affected the times.

Nevertheless, Abigail Jennings following her 3km victory at the England Athletics Indoor championships at Sheffield six days previously, seemed undeterred by the wind and rain to score an impressive win. Turning the clock back, in second place was the 2006/08 League champion Trevor Jones and behind him an excellent ERWL debut by Matt Ellerton. Thirteen year old Trejan Checkiko-Boamoh caught the eye and showed potential.



Enfield H AC Chair Emily MacMahan not only Presented the 2022 Awards, but played an active part as a judges runner, whilst Hon.Secretary Barry Cook undertook the starter's duty.

Belgrave Harrier and Olympian Ray Middleton passed away on Sunday 8th January. He was a dominant figure in British walking for two decades over a range of distances. However his forte was the longer stuff; National titles, records and a remarkable international career. He placed several times in the EO7.
