Jack Fitzgerald Centenary Memorial Walks at Tilgate Park, Crawley on 4th November.

In the year that Jack Fitzgerald would have celebrated his 100th birthday, the Veterans AC hosted the eighth running of this event. The lake around which the course is based was once used as the test bed for Britain's water speed record attempt in the mid-sixties.

There was persistent heavy rain throughout the duration of the race and in the headline event over 9.52 km Leaguers Melanie Peddle was the overall winner and in second place Trevor Jones notched up his second victory in the event. Other Leaguers were Fiona Bishop 67.54, along with Chris Flint © and Stephen Cartwright who finished together in 76.24.

The race was held to raise funds for Blind Veterans UK, as a tribute to RAF fighter pilot Jack Fitzgerald.

VAC are always grateful for our judges and team of officials, especially in these difficult weather conditions, in particular Ron Penfold who is a local resident had been monitoring the state of the course up to the day before; in the end the usual loop was roughly halved and became out and back due to the flooded patches on the return half.

On the same day, two leaguers, Tony Bell 4th/31.54 and Dan Maskell 12th/37.34 were among the seventeen competitors in the Lancashire WC's AGM 5km. The race staged at Simister was won by Ken Connor in 27.28.

The second race in the **Ray Hall Track league** took place at Tonbridge School on 18th November and incorporated with only a fortnights notice, the Southern RWA championships. There was a good turnout with 28 starters including eleven who were aged under fifteen. Gareth Thomas (Tonbridge AC) 21.17.8 and Hannah Hopper (Cambridge H) 25.49.9 emerged as the 5000m winners with Leaguers Jonathan Hobbs 24.27.6 and Grazia Manzotti 26.44.8 occupying the third places in their respective categories. Melanie Peddle 4th/28.16.4. Jacqui Benson 6th/29.03.1 and Penelope Cummings 7th/30.04 also contested the ladies race, whilst David Crane 5th/25.52.5, the men's event
